



# S1 Mid Autumn Festival Moon-Watching Gala cum Parents' Meeting



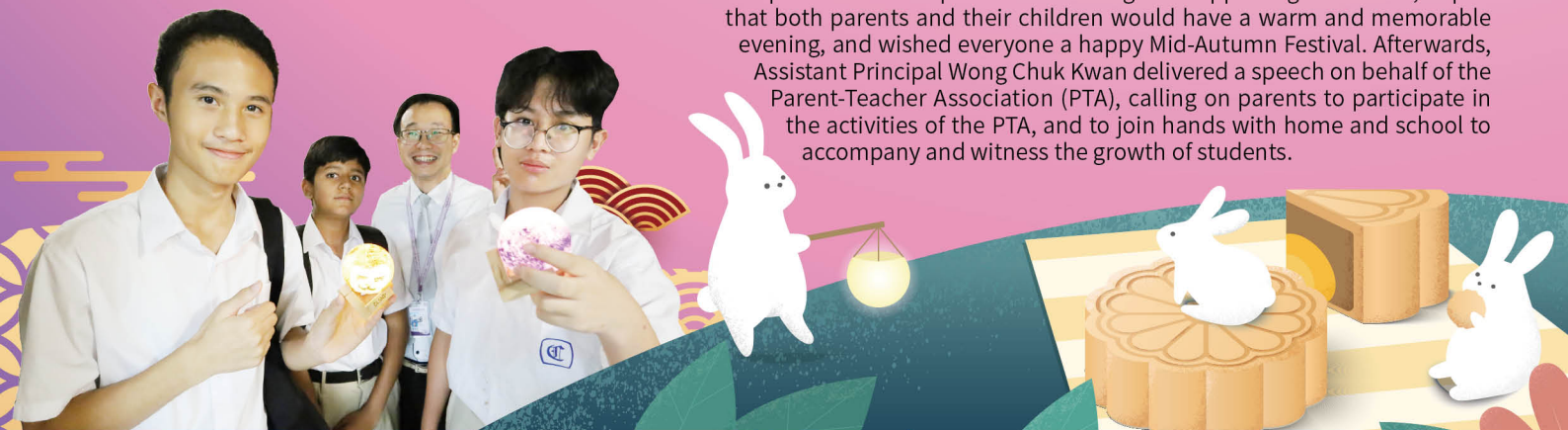
*Celebrating Mid-Autumn Festival with a festive atmosphere on campus*
